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You must use this Worksheet to calculate the reduction of your personal exemption deduction amount if your estimated Maine adjusted gross income for 2018 is greater than \$266,700 if single; \$293,350 if head of household; \$320,000 if married filing jointly or qualifying widow(er); or \$160,000 if married filing separately.

1.	Enter your estimated 2018 Maine adjusted gross income (Form 1040ES-ME, line 5)	1
2.	Enter \$266,700 if single; \$293,350 if head of household; \$320,000 if married filing jointly; or \$160,000 if married filing separately	2
3.	Subtract line 2 from line 1. If zero or less, do not complete this worksheet - your personal exemption amount is not subject to the phaseout	3
4.	Enter \$62,500 if married filing separately; \$125,000 if single or married filing jointly or qualifying widow(er) or head of household.	4
5.	Divide line 3 by line 4. If one or more, enter 1.0000.	5
6.	Enter the 2018 personal exemption amount (\$4,150 if single, head of household, or married filing separately; \$8,300 if married filing jointly or qualifying widow(er)). <i>NOTE: Enter zero if you (or if married filing jointly, both you and your spouse) can be claimed as a dependent on another person's return.</i> If married filing jointly and only one spouse may be claimed on another person's return, enter \$4,150	6
7.	Multiply line 6 by line 5	7
8.	Estimated 2018 Maine personal exemption amount. Subtract line 7 from line 6. Enter this amount on your 2018 Estimated Tax Worksheet, line 6b	8
