4. Enter \$62,500 if married filing separately; \$125,000 if single or married filing jointly or qualifying widow(er) or head of household. 4 _____
5. Divide line 3 by line 4. If one or more, enter 1.0000. 5 _____
6. Enter the 2018 personal exemption amount (\$4,150 if single, head of household, or married filing separately; \$8,300 if married filing jointly or qualifying widow(er)).
NOTE: Enter zero if you (or if married filing jointly, both you and your spouse) can be claimed as a dependent on another person's return. If married filing jointly and only one spouse may be claimed on another person's return, enter \$4,150..... 6 _____
